John Pockocke as to the said estates which consisted of very many perticulors, as pay ments and disburstments and Losses, out of the said estate allso wee Reserved a cobby of the Inven tory of the said estate, by which, comparing the Accounts and the Severall perticulors to be presented, wee find that the said estate seemes to us to be Indepted, sixty fouer pounds two shillings fouer pence..
